

Last-minute filers give Cornish a contest

Filing period closed Tuesday

State Rep. Tony Cornish will have a contest this fall, but a few of his Republican colleagues will sail to uncontested victories.

Mark Meyer (Independence Party) and Joan Muth- Milks (DFL) filed for Cornish's 24B House seat Tuesday, the last day of this filing period.

Democrats did not find candidates to take on Sen.

Julie Roisen, R- Fairmont, and Paul Torkelson, R- St.

James.

In Blue Earth County, two more people filed for the 2nd District seat.

Reggie Edwards and Steve Meyer joined existing candidates Robert Finley and Vance Stuehrenberg.

Other Blue Earth County seats, including for the 1st and 4th districts, will stay with incumbents.
