### **Police break up large house party**

**MANKATO** — Nearly 60 underage consumption citations were issued Friday night after Mankato police responded to a report of a fight at 323 East Walnut St.

When the officers arrived shortly before 11 p.m., the disturbance was over; however, they found a loud party in progress. Many of the people inside the home, who appeared to be younger than 21, were consuming alcoholic beverages.

In addition to the 58 underage-consumption citations, two citations were issued for obstruction of the legal process and three citations were issued for violation of Mankato's social host ordinance.
